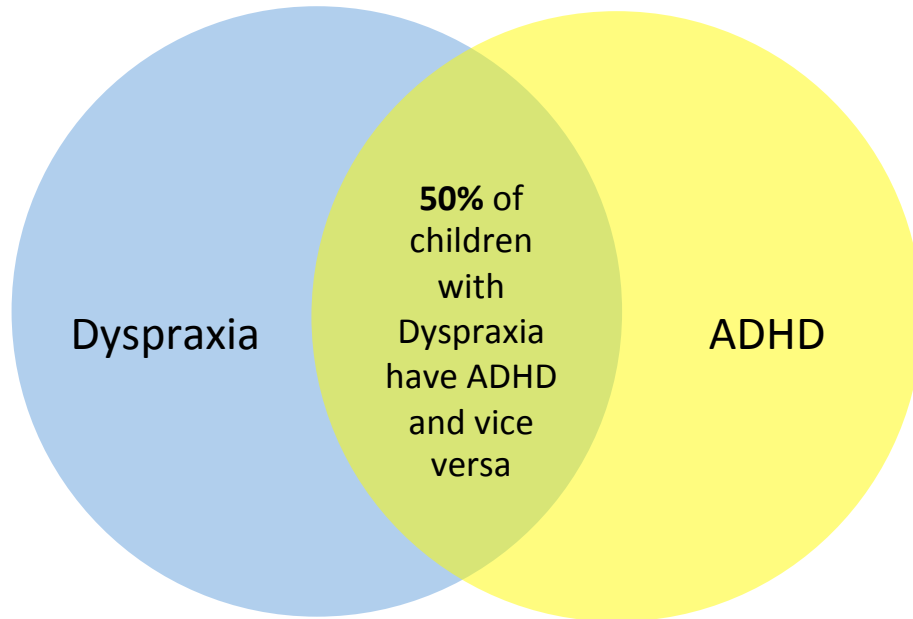


Dyspraxia (DCD) comorbidities



Up to **70%** of children with language problems have comorbid Dyspraxia

Reading and writing disorders commonly overlap with Dyspraxia
